GOAL 1

LAUNCH BFIA



Fact: Football provides health benefits and develops teamwork, discipline and social skills.

Borneo Football International Academy kicked off in March 2015 with 14 young people – word quickly spread and in just two months more than 80 children were attending weekly football training. Today more than 150 children, including three all-girls teams, train at the Rungan Sari complex in Central Kalimantan. Most of the children come from low income families with diverse religious and cultural backgrounds.

Most of the people who work with us do it purely for the love of football and to give back to the community.

BFIA is an official member of the Indonesian Football Association and is run by the Borneo Football International Foundation - a nonprofit based in the Indonesian province of Central Kalimantan.



GOAL 2

GROW THE PROGRAM



FOOTBALL

We hold twice weekly training sessions along with football clinics and Summer camps. Our players also test their skills in official tournaments. The 'Happy Feet' program supports players from low income families with sports shoes and uniforms.




HEALTH AND NUTRITION

Central Kalimantan has one of the highest stunting rates in Indonesia, and we found many of our young players were underweight and below average height. We initiated a program to address this issue, providing nutritional drinks during practice, information on healthy living and a health assessment to measure their physical development.



EDUCATION

In Central Kalimantan, nearly 1 in 3 children aged 7-15 drop out of school mainly due to economic pressures. We support our players with educational materials and school fee subsidies. Sponsorship is also provided for English and computer classes, vocational courses and conservation activities through our partners.



GOAL 3

A PLACE TO CALL HOME

BFIA is quickly outgrowing its small football pitch. To give more children opportunities, it needs to expand quickly. Plans to build a multipurpose football campus are well underway thanks to generous donors who provided a seven-hectare plot of land near the current pitch in Rungan Sari, and funds to get the new campus started.

We began work on the site in 2015, and we are developing football pitches for matches and training, a futsal building, and volleyball courts. An administration and recreational building with a kitchen and cafeteria will support the Health and Nutrition program, while a multi-purpose hall will provide the space for educational sessions and workshops. The quarters for the groundskeeper will complete the campus.
